Ambassadorial Scholarship

In memory of Paul Harris, after his death in 1947 a plan for fellowship between scholars was established. The Ambassadorial Scholarship program allows undergraduate and graduate students to study abroad serving as ambassadors of their country. They represent their country to the Rotary Clubs and other groups of people abroad and after coming home share their experience. Since 1947 up to now nearly 36 000 students from 110 nations received Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarships in the amount of over 429 million USD.
